



#### Q2 Which of the following areas of application for biometrics has been the most interesting to you in 2017?







# Q4 By which of the following dates do you believe biometrics will have replaced the password as the primary method of user authentication online?





#### Q5 On average, how often do you personally use biometrics?







#### Q7 In your opinion, are consumer biometrics still in a nascent phase?







# Q9 Privacy concerns are a major obstacle in consumer biometric adoption.











#### Q13 Biometric screening makes air travel safer and more convenient.









#### Q16 I feel safer in a building protected by biometric security.









#### Q19 Digital and physical privacy is a fundamental right.




